**RULES OF THE INTERNATIONAL PRE-SCHOOL AND PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL  
INSTITUTIONS PROJECT  
“HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN’S TALES IN A DIFFERENT WAY”**

**I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. These regulations govern the purpose, objectives, participant requirements, and the organization and execution procedure of the project "Hans Christian Andersen's Fairy Tales in a Different Way" (hereinafter referred to as the Project).
2. The Project is organized by Vilnius "Žilvinėlio" Preschool (hereinafter referred to as the Organizer), located at Taikos g. 130, Vilnius, LT-05226, email: rastine@zilvinelis.vilnius.lm.lt, phone: +37052419212.
3. The Project is dedicated to celebrating the birthday of the famous fairy tale creator Hans Christian Andersen, which is commemorated worldwide as International Children's Book Day.
4. The initiator of the Project is the Deputy Director for Education of Vilnius "Žilvinėlio" Preschool, Gintarė Bladžinauskienė.
5. The Project coordinators are the preschool teachers-methodologists Jolanta Kulikauskienė and Violeta Dulko.

## **II. OBJECTIVES AND TASKS**

7. **Objective:** Using the motifs from Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tales, create contexts and provide opportunities for children's creativity, self-expression, language development, emotional expression, and critical thinking, ensuring their comprehensive education.
8. **Tasks:**
  - 8.1. Read Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tales with the children.
  - 8.2. Develop language and communication skills by encouraging children's language development through reading, discussions, and storytelling.
  - 8.3. Enhance imagination and creative thinking by reinterpreting the plots of the fairy tales in the context of the modern world.
  - 8.4. Foster social and emotional skills by discussing themes of friendship, selflessness, courage, and love, helping children recognize and express their emotions and understand others'.
  - 8.5. Encourage children's creativity and self-expression by having them retell fairy tales in their own words and illustrate them with drawings.
  - 8.6. Familiarize children with the best works of world literature and their moral lessons, which are relevant for all generations.

## **III. PARTICIPANTS OF THE PROJECT**

9. The Project invites participation from preschool and pre-school education children, educators, educational support specialists, and parents from Lithuania and abroad.

## **IV. PROJECT ORGANIZATION**

10. The Project will run from April 1, 2025, to May 15, 2025.
11. Participants should submit a registration form (Appendix 1) by email to [j.kulikauskiene@gmail.com](mailto:j.kulikauskiene@gmail.com).
12. During the specified period, participants will organize activities:
  - 12.1. Select a book or work by Hans Christian Andersen to read with the children.
  - 12.2. Reinterpret the plot of the selected fairy tale in the context of the present time.
  - 12.3. Illustrate the reinterpreted fairy tale with children's drawings.
13. Participants choose their own methods, forms, and approaches for these activities.
14. Participants must upload two quality photos or a collage (one with the story and title, the other with the illustration) to the "Andersen's Fairy Tales in a Different Way" closed Facebook group between April 1 and May 15, 2025.

15. When uploading the two photos or collage, it is necessary to include the country, city, institution name, teacher's name, and the child's or children's group age.
16. At the end of the Project, all activities will be compiled into a virtual book, which will be shared on the Facebook group "Andersen's Fairy Tales in a Different Way" and on the preschool's website <https://www.zilvinelis.lt/>.

## **V. FINAL PROVISIONS**

17. By uploading creative photos or collages, participants agree to their publication online and their use in promoting the project.
18. By uploading content, authors confirm that they are the creators of the photos, and they take responsibility for any copyright violations.
19. All project participants will receive certificates and acknowledgments from Vilnius "Žilvinėlio" Preschool, along with a list of participants.
